

ADDITIONS TO THE VASCULAR FLORA OF ALBANIA

ABSTRACT - I present here a list of 12 species heretofore unrecorded for Albania, together with a map showing the extension of *Lemna minuta* in southern Europe. *Caldesia pannassifolia* is recorded from the Lake Skadar, Montenegro.

INTRODUCTION

The aquatic and wetland species listed hereafter are not indicated in the Flora e Shqipërisë (Flore de l'Albanie) by Paparisto *et al.* (1988), Qosja *et al.*, (1992, 1996), Vangjeli *et al.* (2000). The specimens are conserved in my herbarium and will eventually be housed in the Conservatoire Botanique of Geneva.

Bidens frondosa L. Liqën Shkodër, 23.07.2000; lijen Ohrid at Lin, 1.07.2002.

Carex cuprina (Sand ex Heuf.) Nend. (*C. otrubae* Popd.). Devoll river north of Plasa, 2.07.2002.

Carex viridula Michaux (*C. serotina* Mérat). Peatbog east of Bulqizës, after the bridge, 30.06.2002

Cyperus badius Desfontaines, 1798. [*C. longus* L. var. *badius* (Desf.) Camb., 1827; *C. longus* subsp. *badius* (Desf.) Murbeck, 1899]. Mouth of a torrent at Bunjet (southwestern littoral), 26.06.2002; river near Derviçan, 25.06.2002. *Cyperus longus* L., a quite distinct species, occurs in the interior and northern part of Albania.

Eleocharis uniglumis (Link) Schultes. Peatbog east of Bulqizës, after the bridge, 30.06.2002; Lake Ohrid: Boqze, 1.07.2002.

Glyceria maxima (Hartmann) Holmberg. Korça region: canal, 1 km northwest of Plasa, 2.07.2002.

Lemna minuta Humboldt, Bonpland & Kunth, 1816 (*L. minima* Phil., *L. minuscula* Herter). Canal 2 km north of Cangonji north of Tirana, 29.06.2002; Korça region: canal at Dishnica, 2.07.2002; river northeast of Plasa, 2.07.2002; canal 1 km northwest of Plasa, 2.07.2002. This species is in rapid expansion in southern Europe. See map.

Salvinia natans (L.) Allioni. Roskovec, 27.07.2001.

Schoenoplectus litoralis (Schrader) Palla. Canal, 10 km south of Fier south of Tirana, 26.07.2001.

Scirpoides holoschoenus (L.) Soják subsp. **australis** (Murray) Soják, 1972. This taxon is indicated as *Scirpus holoschoenus* L. (*Holoschoenus vulgaris* Link) in Flora e Shqipërisë (op. cit.), p. 402. *Scirpoides holoschoenus* subsp. *holoschoenus* (*Holoschoenus vulgaris*) does not occur in Albania where only the widespread subsp. *australis* occurs. See Desfayes, 2004, Flora Medit. 14 (in prep.).

Spirodela polyrhiza (L.) Schleider. Abundant in a canal, 5 km south of Durrës, 29.06.2002.

Typha laxmannii Lepechin. Peza west of Tirana, passed the town, before the bridge on the river Ezren. 28.07.2001, 2.07.2002; Ballsh, 14 km south of Patos, 28.07.2001.

ADDENDUM

Caldesia parnassifolia (Bassi) Parlatore. It appears worthwhile to mention here the presence of this very rare and endangered species in Europe, in Lake Skadar (Shkodër, Scutari), Montenegro, 23.07.2001. Exact location withheld.
